Just as God reigns in his Kingdom, we must acknowledge his will is sovereign.

We should expect God's will to make his holy people look different than the world.

John 17:14-16 I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it.

We should expect God's will to make his holy people look different than the world.

Colossians 3:8-10, 12

But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed ...

We should expect God's will to make his holy people look different than the world.

Colossians 3:8-10, 12 in knowledge in the image of its Creator. Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

God's will should shape the church. We must be careful that discernment does not abandon God's truth.

The church has these difficult tasks:

Listening for the will of God

Discerning how to pragmatically take action

Repenting when we fall short

**Our Confessions** 

created by God to be cared for and enjoyed. God has a plan for what he has created and will accomplish God's purposes in the end.

**Our Confessions** 

Humans are created in the image of God so that we can have a personal and communal relationship with God. This image gives dignity and enables us to love. It also sets us above and makes us responsible for the non-human creation.

**Our Confessions** 

The history of sin, death, evil, and pain were begun by rebellion against God and can only be undone by the justice of God.

**Our Confessions** 

Though God is one, God is presented in three persons (Father, Son and Spirit)—the Trinity.

**Our Confessions** 

The Son, Jesus Christ, is completely God and became a complete human being. His life revealed God to us. His death satisfied the justice of God for the original rebellion and the evil that followed. His resurrection overcame the power of death and gave us life with God after death.

**Our Confessions** 

The Holy Spirit is completely God and does the work of the Father and Son. The Spirit teaches, gives gifts, and transforms us back into God's image.

**Our Confessions** 

Jesus will return to finally overthrow evil and death forever and to set up a new heaven and a new earth where we can be with Jesus forever. God will rule over everything.
